Finally, work on spelling and grammar. Things that I noticed the most were misspelled words and sentence structure/organization. For example, if I were to re-write the first sentence to your last paragraph, it would look like this: In conclusion, dirt bike riding is one of my favorite and most shocking things to do. I reorganized your sentence to express that dirt biking was one of your most favorite and shocking hobbies, but still is. By reorganizing, you are telling your reader you still love to dirt bike and it is shocking whenever you learn something new or something goes awry and you are able to handle it. Sometimes I have a hard time seeing my own mistakes, so I have

Good. You have told me where you go, who you go with, and what you do when you bike. Now focus a little on those three parts to develop your paragraph further. Tell me more.

- Instead of focusing on where Prairie City is, tell me what it is like there. Are the trails challenging or basic? Are there lots of trails to ride around for hours and hours? What is the scenery like? These are some options you could use to expand.
- You say that you bring friends so they can enjoy riding like you. What do you mean by that? You probably understand your reasoning for that sentence, but your readers are going to be left wondering what do they do when they enjoy their time riding?

I like how you explain that every time you go riding you try to learn something new. That tells your readers about who you are. It tells me you are goal oriented and up for a challenge, but what kind of challenge? Give me an example of what it is you've tried to learn. Maybe, briefly write about your most recent accomplishment.

You have done a good job at concluding your essay. You have summarized three major aspects of your essay: favorite hobby, time with your dad and friends, and your sense of accomplishment.

a friend read my paper to point out specifically what I need to correct. You could do this too if you feel it would help.

Once again, I am impressed with the changes you have made and look forward to reading your final draft. You are almost done!
